Our draft concept of the structure is below. Please be advised that finishing touches such as railings and accessible ramps will be added to the concept at a later date.

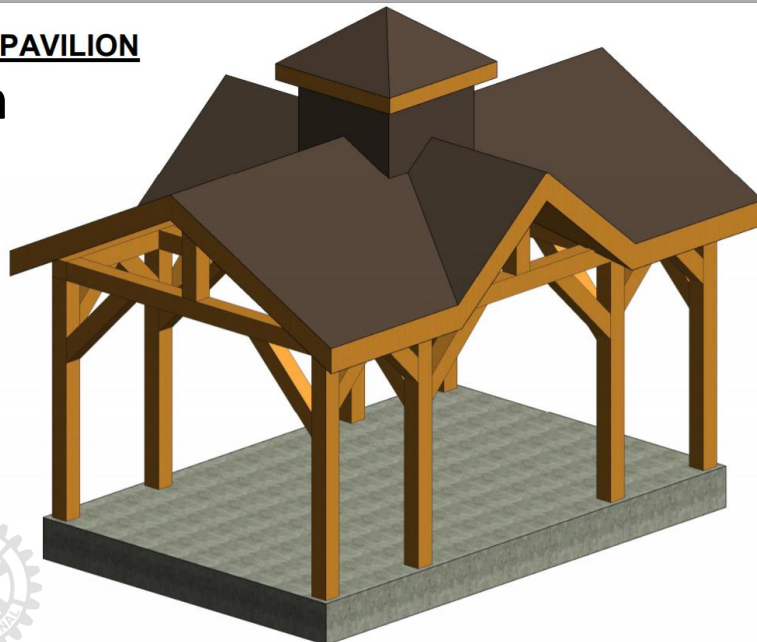

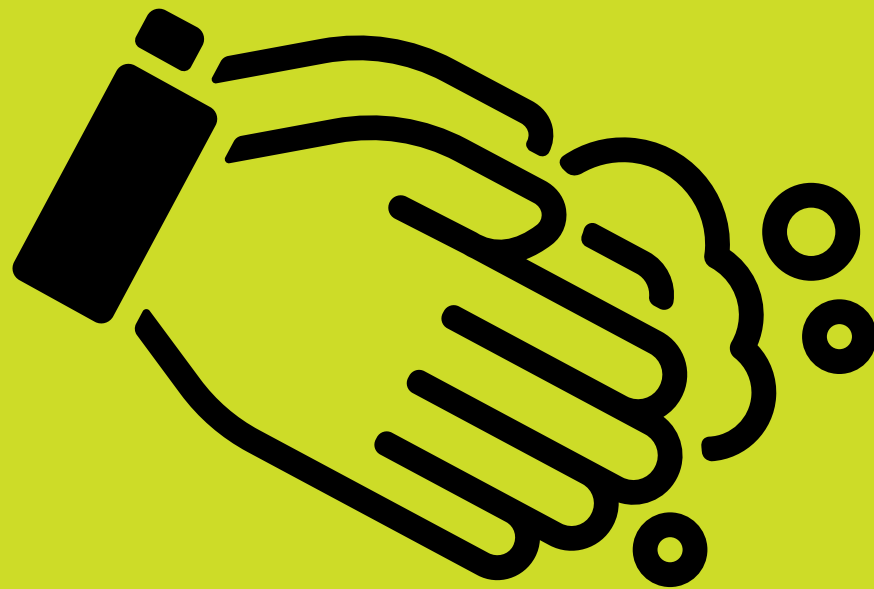
